The minimum specifications provided reflect the requirements for connection to the BYOD Gateway. Our College Computer Technicians will make every effort to enable connectivity of devices which meet these minimum specifications, assuming there are no technical or other issues outside of their control.

The following devices are NOT supported on the school network: Apple iPads, Chromebooks and Android devices;
