Student Digital Resource Scheme - BYOD Agreement

The College community has supported a co-contribution Laptop supply option be included in the SRS. This is the College's preferred option for students. College owned laptops are covered by accidental damage protection as per the iLearn Agreement, and replacements are available if a device is not working.

You have advised that you have chosen not to participate in the College Laptop supply option, and alternatively purchase one for your student.

It is an expectation that all students will use their device appropriately in line with the college Positive Relationships Agreement and the Student Code of Conduct and will only only use digital learning technologies on College site (including the internet and emails) for learning related activities.

Upon enrolment in a Queensland Government school, parental or caregiver permission is sought to give the student(s) access to the internet, based upon the policy contained within https://ppr.qed.qld.gov.au/attachment/use-of-ict-systems-procedure.pdf. This policy also forms part of this Student Device Charter. The acceptable-use conditions apply to the use of the device and internet both on and off the school grounds. Communication through internet and online communication services must comply with the agreements signed on enrolment.

There are a few conditions that students should adhere to. Students should not:

- create, participate in or circulate content that attempts to undermine, hack into and/or bypass the hardware and/or software security mechanisms that are in place
- disable settings for virus protection, spam and/or internet filtering that have been applied as part of the school standard
- use unauthorised schemes and intentionally download unauthorised software, graphics or music
- intentionally damage or disable computers, computer systems or Queensland DOE networks
- use the device for unauthorised commercial activities, political lobbying, online gambling or any unlawful purpose.

Note: Students' use of internet and online communication services may be audited at the request of appropriate authorities for investigative purposes surrounding inappropriate use.

By signing below, you acknowledge that the laptop purchased by you for your student is not covered by the College for any damages or loss that may occur to the device, including on College site, and a College Fleet device may not be accessible if your laptop is damaged.
